More Ways to Protect Sheep



Llamas bond with sheep and will protect them from predators by chasing and kicking them.

Mixed "flerds" (flock/herd) of sheep and cattle can protect sheep because sheep can hide from predators among the larger cattle. For this to work the sheep must be raised alongside the cattle so that they bond.

Donkeys will bray, kick, and try to bite predators that could kill the sheep in their flock.
